Health and Wellness Services

As a valuable benefit, Quality Pork Processors provides on-site health services for employees and their families. The Quality Health and Wellness Clinic is available to provide preventative care, routine screenings as well as primary care needs for employees and their families.

Convenient, High Quality Healthcare

The Quality Health and Wellness Clinic provides a wide range of health services focused on health and wellness; including treatment for illnesses, exams, labs, immunizations and other preventive services. This clinic offers convenient day-time hours with same-day appointments, and no out-of-pocket cost to patients.

Eligibility to Use the Medcor Clinic

Employees (and dependents) of Quality Pork Processors enrolled in the QPP Benefits Plan may use the Quality Health and Wellness Clinic. Additionally, employees (only) enrolled in a spouse's health plan may also use the clinic. Clinic practitioners will see adults and children ages two years and older.

Available Services

The Quality Health and Wellness Clinic is staffed and equipped to handle complex and minor cases, including the following services:

- **Diagnosis and treatment for illnesses and conditions, such as:**
 - Colds, coughs, sore throats and flu symptoms
 - Ear aches; sinus infections
 - Urinary tract infections
 - Strains and sprains
 - Cuts, abrasions, burns and bruises
- **Physical Exams**
 - Health risk assessments
 - Well woman and well man exams
 - Well child exams for children 2 years and older
 - General, school, sports and camp physicals
 - Blood pressure checks
 - Blood sugar and diabetic monitoring
 - Cholesterol monitoring
- **Chronic condition management**
- **Medication management**
- **Immunizations (including flu, tetanus and others)**
- **Lab tests such as:**
 - Rapid Strep
 - Influenza
 - Mono Test
 - Pregnancy Test
 - Glucose Level
 - Urinalysis

Professional Staffing

The clinic is staffed with a Physician Assistant (PA) or Nurse Practitioner (NP) as well as a registered nurse (RN) and a medical assistant (MA). The clinic staff is experienced, caring, and dedicated to their patients' overall health and well-being.

Physician Assistant and Nurse Practitioner Services

Physician Assistants and Nurse Practitioners are healthcare professionals licensed to practice medicine with physician supervision. After college undergraduate studies, they attend an accredited graduate program. PAs and NPs perform physical examinations, diagnose and treat illnesses, order and interpret lab tests, perform procedures as well as provide patient education and counseling. PAs and NPs practice in all areas of medicine.
